

Quarantine Protocol

- If you test positive for COVID19:
 - Call your supervisor immediately to inform them of positive test. Help supervisor with contact tracing as required.
 - Sign the Authorization to Disclose (for contact tracing purposes).
 - Quarantine at home for 10 days from date of diagnosis. Must receive 2 negative rapid COVID tests 24 hours apart, or one negative PCR COVID test before returning to work.

- If someone in your household tests positive for COVID19:
 - Call your supervisor immediately to inform them of household member positive test. Help supervisor with contact tracing if required; if so, sign the Authorization to Disclose.
 - Quarantine away from work and away from positive household member if possible. Once your household member receives a negative COVID test, you must then also receive a negative test before returning to work.
 - We must see evidence of household member's positive test and negative test, and your negative test results.

- If you were recently in close contact with someone who tested positive for COVID19:
 - Close contact is defined as within 6 ft for more than 15 minutes.
 - Inform your supervisor that you have been exposed. Leave work and depending on date of exposure, get tested for COVID19.
 - On the 5th day after exposure, you must receive a negative test before returning to work.

- If you attend a gathering such as a wedding or funeral with more than 10 people indoors or more than 25 people outdoors:
 - On the 5th day after gathering, you must receive a negative test before returning to work.
